Go on a wild walk and search for spooky nature this Halloween.

Tick them off as you see them; how many can you spot?



Skeleton leaves - leaf mining caterpillars live inside leaves making funky patterns as they munch away!



'Zombie' caterpillar - lots of caterpillars hide in the soil/leaf litter in the day and come out at night to eat!



A **Moths Lair** - log or stick piles are perfect hiding places for moths



Cobwebs aka insect traps!



Rotting fruit = a delicious meal for butterflies



Lichen - often found on tombstones or old trees, lichen provides great camouflage for some moths.
